

Basic Metal Clay Toolkit for Workshops

The list below includes some basic tools that you may need for your workshop. Your particular workshop may not use all of these tools. Please refer to the specific tool requirements for your workshop.:

- Non-stick work surface
- Roller
- Spacers or playing cards
- Teflon or similar to put work on a hotplate or dehydrator
- Moisturising/storage pot or plastic wrap/cling film
- Metal clay shaping tools eg clay shapers
- Small water pot, preferably with a lid
- Release agent eg Olive oil, Badger Balm, Slik, CoolSlip
- Rubber block
- Needle/ pin tool
- Exacto knife, craft knife, scalpel
- Hand drill/ pin vice and range of drill bits eg 0.8mm, 1mm
- Tweezers
- Tooth picks/ cocktail sticks
- Snake roller
- Small, sharp scissors
- Good quality paint brushes – various sizes and profiles
- Abrasive papers, sanding sponges for dry stage working
- Needle files, various shapes and/or emery board (400 or 600 grit)
- Polishing tools:
 - Brass or stainless steel brush
 - Burnisher
 - Sanding sponges in 3 grits, or finer abrasive paper
 - Metal polish
 - Polishing cloth
- Pliers, cutters etc (optional)
